1. The History of rallies in Sultanate of Oman

The first signs and initiatives for the practice of the rallies sport appeared in Oman by the end of last century, especially in the year 1977 after a group of amateur rally fans prepared some private cars despite their lack of experience in this area and the limited availability of spare parts required in this field. And this formed the first nucleus for the sport of rally cars in general until the first Middle East rally championship had been officially organized in 1979 with the Sultanate of Oman hosting one of the Middle East rally championship rounds with the participation of a good number of rally champions from the Middle East. The Swedish driver Harri Kallstrom - Datsun 160 managed to win first place at the rally, and the Kenyan driver Chiker Muhanna came in second place in this race, which witnessed many of the roads, and tracks that the Oman Sultanate is famous for. **Middle East Rallies:** The Sultanate succeeded in hosting several regional rallies including the Middle East rally over the past years, we summarize them in the following table:

The organizing committee has arranged a private security company to monitor the service park; however, the organizers are not responsible for any missing or damaged units.

Medical Centre:

A medical center with an ambulance will be located in the service park

Regulations and restrictions:

Within the service park:

The service regulations will be run in compliance with article 12 of the FIA General Prescriptions.

Service vehicles are allowed to enter the service park area on Sunday 19th of January from 10:00AM Hrs. and follow the instructions of the service park manager.

It's compulsory for service vehicles gaining access to the service parks to display the appropriate plate which shall be affixed on the inside of the wind screen in the top right-hand corner.

It's forbidden under any circumstances to drill holes in the tarmac or the ground at the service park. Teams and competitors are asked to bring weights for tents and others that need to be fastened.

Service teams are required to use protecting canvas, which does not let any liquid leak through, underneath the competing cars at all times due to environment purposes.

6. Two-way Radio:

Due to the local licensing regulations, the use of two way radios is not permitted in the Oman Int. Rally 2026



7. Fuel / Tires:

7.1 Fuel

7.1.1 Competitors may only refuel in the refuel zones designated by the organizer in the road book.

7.1.2 These Refuel Areas will be established immediately after the exit from service parks. Their entry/exit shall be marked by a blue fuel pump symbol.

7.1.3 only actions inside a refueling zone that are directly involved in the refueling of the competing car are permitted.

7.1.4 In the refueling zone, a 5 km/h speed limit will apply.

7.1.5 In order to access the RA, all personnel involved in refueling operations must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top, closed shoes, gloves and a balaclava

7.1.6 The responsibility for refueling is incumbent on the competitor alone.

7.1.6.1 solely for the purpose of assisting with the refueling procedure of their car, two team members of each crew may access the refueling zone

7.1.7 Engines must be switched off throughout the refueling operation.

7.1.8 The crew shall remain outside the car during refueling.

7.1.9 When necessary, as part of service (i.e. changing a fuel tank or pump, changing of fuel filter, changing of any other item of the fuel circuit) emptying and /or Refilling is permitted in a service park provided that:

- Work is carried out with the knowledge of the organizer.
- No other work is carried out on the car while the fuel circuit is open and/or during emptying and/or refilling operation.
- A suitable safety perimeter is established around the car.



- fire extinguishers with operator on standby to be provided by the competitor.
- Only sufficient fuel is added to reach the next refuel zone.

7.2 Tires

7.2.1 For all competitors, tire changes may only be carried out in authorized Zones.

7.2.2 In accordance with article 13.1.5 of the FIA regional Rally Merc championships
Sporting regulations, (Tire quantities)
The overall quantity of tires for use at each Championship rally is:

- For competitors entered with RC2 and RGT cars, a maximum of 16 tires may be used during each rally.
- For competitors entered with RC3, RC4 and RC5 cars, a maximum of 12 tires may be used during each rally.

7.2.3 Tire Regulations Breach

Any breach of the tire regulations will be submitted to the stewards and may result in a penalty, which may go as far as the exclusion of the crew by the stewards.



11. Reconnaissance

11.1 Procedure for registration

11.1.1 The reconnaissance time table, reconnaissance time cards and the fitting of GPS monitoring equipment will be available at Rally Office in Sohar on Tuesday 20th Jan. 2026 from 8.00.

11.1.2 When registering for the reconnaissance one of the crew members must be present to sign an indemnity, register the details of the Reconnaissance car, mobile telephone numbers and contact details of the place of resident.



11.1.3 Reconnaissance car identification numbers must be attached to the front windscreen (top center) and on the right and left rear side windows. They must be kept visible for the duration of the reconnaissance period.

11.1.4 Crews are authorized to drive a maximum of 2 (two) times through Each Special stage during the Reconnaissance period in accordance with the timetable shown in Appendix II of the Supp. Reg. Only a total of 2 passes will be permitted When a Special Stage is used more than once in the same configuration.

11.2 Schedule.

11.3 Specific regulations

It is emphasized that reconnaissance is not practice. The competitors Must drive in a manner that does not endanger or cause Inconvenience to traffic or people living near the stages. All road traffic laws of Oman must be strictly complied with and the safety of other road users must be respected.

11.3.1 Crews will not be allowed to drive in the opposite direction of the rally Route on special stages.

11.3.2 Crews are required to present their Reconnaissance time card at the Start and Finish of all Special Stages. Cars will only be



permitted to enter and leave the special stages through the Start and Finish controls.

- 11.3.3 The presence of any entrant and/or crew member entered in the Rally On any part of a Special Stage, in any way whatsoever, is considered As Reconnaissance. Reconnaissance outside the schedule set by the Organizers is considered as a very serious offence and will be reported to the Stewards, who may apply penalties at their discretion.
- 11.3.4 Reconnaissance will start on 20th Jan. 2026 at 08.00 and will finish on 21st Jan. 2026 at 16.00. This regulation applies to all crews. If, outside the scheduled times, any crew and/or competitor is found on any Part of any Special Stage to be used in the Rally, he or she will be Reported to the Stewards. If this involved an Omani licensed driver, he or she will be subject to national suspension. In the case of a foreign licensed crew/competitor, he or she will be reported to the respective ASN which will take appropriate action.
- 11.3.5 All Reconnaissance for all crews will only be carried out using series production cars of two or four wheel drive as per article 35.1 of RRSR 2026. Reconnaissance cars must be covered by insurance as required by the laws of Oman. No responsibility being imputable to the Organisers.
- 11.3.6 The maximum speed limit of 70 km/h is imposed on all special Stages. Speed will be monitored by GPS tracking devices carried by all reconnaissance cars.
- 11.3.7 Any infringement of the reconnaissance regulations will be reported to the Stewards who may impose penalties under article 34.2.2 of the FIA RRSR. Furthermore, the Stewards may report the Competitors concerned to the FIA for possible further sanctions.

11.4 Registration, Fitment of tracking and speed control devices.

Registration for Reconnaissance and the collection of the Reconnaissance number plates, time cards and time schedule will Take place as stated in the Rally Programme.



11.4.1 A system of monitoring the speed, routing and position of reconnaissance cars during reconnaissance of all special stages by means of GPS tracking devices will be used. Details and times for the fitting of these tracking units will be contained in a Bulletin.

12. Scrutineering, Sealing and Marking

12.1 Location: Royal Oman Police Regional Vehicles Inspection area - Sohar.
Time: Wednesday, 21st Jan. 2026 at 15.00H according to a timetable issued in a bulletin.

12.2 Scrutineering provisions:

- According to Article 11 of the 2026 OIR Supplementary Regulation.

Crews arriving late at scrutineering shall be fined as follows:

Euros 15€ per minute to maximum of 15 minutes. Thereafter, the Competitor will be reported to the Stewards who may apply penalties at their discretion.

- Noise Level: at any time on the road sections, the noise level must be in conformity with appendix J , Article 252.3.6
- The installed extinguishing systems and manual extinguishers of the competing cars will have to comply with the regulations of appendix j of the FIA (art. 253.7) and are compulsory all competing vehicles.
- A first aid kit, and reflecting triangle are to be used as warning for following cars in the event of road blockages, therefore it's obligatory in every car.

Infringements may be subject to the penalty of refusal to start.

13. Shakedown

Recces of Shakedown will be held on Wednesday 21st January from 8:00 till 12:00.

Shakedown stage will be run on Thursday 22nd January from 9:00 till 11:00. SD length 5.50 km. Total 9.25km.

The ceremonial start of the Rally will be held on Thursday, 22nd Jan. 2026 at 14:30 hrs., preceded by a pre-rally press conference on-ramp and a pre-ceremonial holding area at 13:30 hrs in Sohar Entertainment Center under the patronage and presence of North Al Batinah Governor, many government officials, with the presence VIP officials, and more Motor Sport Fans, and it will last about 60 minutes.

The Ceremonial Start is obligatory for all competing cars and crews.

The crews with its cars are required to be present, and any absence will be reported to the Stewards.

The car will then proceed to a pre-holding area prior to TCO at the exit of Service Park to start leg1 heading to tc1 at the SSS1 near the Venue.

Reporting to Pre-Start Area and instruction:

All competing cars are required to enter the pre-start holding area between 13:30-14:00 Hours on Thursday 22nd Jan. 2026.

The crew members do not have to be present when the car enters the start pre-start holding area.

Competitors reporting late to the Ceremonial start will be penalized with €30 per minute or the equivalent in local currency up to a maximum of 15 minutes. Thereafter, they will be reported to the Stewards who may apply penalties at their discretion.

Starting order and Procedure:

- The starting order for the start of the rally will be in descending order.
- All cars will pause on the podium for approx. 1 minute.

15. Prize giving (Finish area Procedure)

Location and time:

The finish prize giving podium will be held at the Sohar Entertainment Center Grand Theater On Saturday 24th of Jan. 2026 at 18:30 PM with a big ceremony attended by many government and VIP officials.



Procedure and instructions:

- The rally will finish TC 13 C Holding IN (Sohar Entertainment Center) **Finish** of Rally.

The finish ceremony will be at the at 18:30, the Rally Officials will direct the cars to the finish podium in a special route reserved to the Rally cars.

Rally officials will give a request to the drivers to forward to the finish ramp at a time up to the request of the clerk of the course.

The third overall driver will drive to the top of the ramp, stop with nose of the car dropped onto the exit ramp, stop engine. The crew will get out and stand on either side of the car with doors open wave for the photographers, drive off and park the car so it is positioned on the left-hand side of the podium, the crew goes to the VIP area.

Second overall, same procedure as third overall, car to be positioned on the right-hand side of the podium.

The winner drives on to the finish ramp with nose dropped onto the exit, the crew gets out, close doors and climbs onto the bonnet, maybe joined by team personnel, team personnel leave ramp, the car stays on the ramp until the finish of the ceremony.

The box podium is moved into position in front of the finish ramp and the winning car.

The winning crews are then called from the VIP area to stand behind the appropriate box; dignitaries are called to present the awards.

The national anthem of the winning driver then will be played.

The winning driver will then drive the car down the ramp to the parc ferme. Then the 1st Omani competitor will drive to the Ramp, stop with nose of the car dropped onto the exit ramp, stop engine. The crew will get out and stand on either side of the car with doors open wave for the photographers, the Omani national anthem will be played.



All other crews will drive over the ramp then to parc ferme, the winners of groups and classes and other trophies (as mentioned in the Supplementary regulations) will get trophies on the ramp.


